Rules and Regulations

1. Numbered tennis balls will be dropped from the top of a fire truck ladder onto a set target area at Elings Park, Santa Barbara, California, at approximately 1 PM on September 11, 2010.
2. All tennis balls used for the ball drop will be individually marked with numbers that correspond to purchased tickets.
3. The winning tennis balls will be balls that fall into the target cups, or balls that land closest to the targets if no ball falls into the target cups, and or balls selected by a ball - retrieving dog.
4. Tickets will be purchased for \$10 for one (1) ball, or \$90 for ten (10) balls, and there is no limit to the number of tickets purchased by an eligible entrant.
5. Ticket purchases are not tax-deductible. Ticket sales are final and non refundable.
6. Odds of winning are dependent on the total number of valid tickets, as well as where the balls land.
7. Winners will be announced at the event. Winners not present will be notified by phone, mail, or email based on contact information supplied.
8. If a winner cannot be located or fails to claim prize within thirty (30) days after notification, the prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.
9. If the Ball Drop is cancelled due to weather or other circumstances, the prizes will be awarded by a random drawing for winning tickets.
10. All decisions and interpretations of contest rules will be made by K-9 PALS and/or The Elings Park Foundation and will be final.
11. Entrants must be 18 yrs. or older.
